

Monitoring Violations Annual Notice Template

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for [Anna-Jonesboro Water Commission]

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During [10/1/2023 – 12/31/2023] we [did not complete all monitoring or testing] for [Total Haloacetic Acids] and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for [Total Haloacetic Acids], how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

What happened? What is being done?

[Samples will be taken on specified date by the IEPA or will be taken immediately to allow the lab adequate time to analyze the samples. The above samples were taken in sufficient time and received by the IEPA lab. However, due to Lab error, the samples were not used and a resample was required. At which time we resampled and those results were not allowed for compliance due to the Lab not submitting the results by the specified date and time.]
